Approval of 2024 Minutes – not available at this time

Treasurer's Report: to date \$226,006.11 in operating money, \$46,180.53 in expenses (includes new mailbox units, springs for mbu doors, road maintenance, snow removal, etc). Additional mowing, weed spraying, snow removal, road maintenance, will add to expenses for the remainder of 2025.

Question from the audience: is it possible to swing the mbu doors the other direction? – response from Don “unfortunately, it is not an available option, please remember to close the doors when collecting packages so the wind does not have an opportunity to catch them and blow them open.”

Approve the treasurers report as written, motion to approve, all in favor, no opposed.

Neighborhood picnic was a success and will continue to be the 4th Saturday of June from here forward.

New business: new mbu parcel units to be installed Sept 6 at 9am, will need hammer drills, portable generator, cut off saw, people. Meet at Steve Ross' house, 3rd entrance.

Resealing blacktop is scheduled middle of September.

Board term limits amendment – 2 year terms for top 3 vote receivers, 1 year term for bottom 2 vote receivers for 2025 vote, followed by 2 year terms for every year thereafter.

Votes cast and received – 25 yes, 1 no – board term limits amendment passes.
